Panel Reports:

SLO County Jail Men (Mike) (1 year clean, 5 years no contact) (Tuesdays @ 5:15). We go into this facility weekly. One new person has been cleared (David). He has been in twice, once with Rick and once with Mike. Mike received an invitation from Lt Cole for Mike and any other volunteers (who are cleared for SLO Jail) to attend a play put on by Poetic Justice. It will be on 10/28/11 at 6pm. There will be no cost to our volunteers. Mike will inquire whether members who are not cleared for SLO Jail facility can attend.

SLO County Jail Women (Patrice) (1 year clean, 5 years no contact) (Thursdays @ 7:15). Four other women and I go into this facility weekly. We are always looking for more women to get cleared and support this panel.

EOC Homeless Men & Women (Greg) (90 days clean) (Tuesdays @ 7:00). Panel going good. There are up to ten people attending this panel (including a guitar player). There are always two members present.

CMC Men (Josh) (No parole or Probation) (East Wednesdays @ 6:00, West 1st & 3rd Thursday @7). The panels are going good. Two members are always present. We are having problems getting clearances again. I was approached by a member of another 12 step fellowship who expressed interest going in on panels with us. I explained to him that NA members are responsible for supporting NA panels and that he should support a panel in the fellowship he is a member of.
