JBCT Unit 3:00PM to 4:00PM: This is the dual diagnosis unit inside county jail. It holds both men and women. Both gender volunteers are needed. Currently we have 1 male cleared covering. We could use 3 to 4 or even 7 to 8 more men to cover for the month. This month we have had 4 men & 2 women the first week

in attendance. Week 2 & 3 we had an even 3 men 3 women attend. The 4th week there were 2 men & 4 women in attendance.

SLO Men's Co. Jail: Stanley (805) 296-0076

Tuesday Night 5:30PM - We see 700 & 800 West Dorms simultaneously. Could use 1 or 2 more men volunteers. 700 has steady attendance between 4 to 8 men. 800 has weekly attendance between 8 to 10 men.

Thursday: Kansas Max (K-MAX) 1:00PM to 2:00PM - We are currently rotating between pods. There are 4 men cleared rotating every other week. Pods have asked for weekly meetings. We could use 6 to 8 men to make this happen as a one week a month commitment. The units see regular attendance ranging from 4 to 6 men.

300 West Housing 5:30PM to 6:30PM - They have a weekly attendance of 12 to 14 men. 2 volunteers cover on an every other week rotation. We could use 3 to 7 more volunteers.

400 West Housing 5:45PM to 6:45PM - They have a weekly attendance of 8 to 12 men. 2 volunteers cover on an every other week rotation. We could also use 3 to 7 more volunteers to help cover this unit.

SLO Women's Co. Jail: Jan (818) 438-1654 / Stanley (805) 296-0076Monday Night: 6:00PM – I Deck 10 women cleared each panel of two covers one week a month only. We cannot take any more volunteers for this unit as our limit was 8.

6:15PM – J Deck Dark due to no women volunteers We are asking for 8 to 10 women.

Thursday Night R Deck 5:30PM: We have two dark weeks a month due to lack of volunteers.

SB County Jail (Santa Maria): Mike (805) 215-4215

Had good communication. 6 people are being processed for clearance. Seem to be concerned about people being cleared for both SLO and SB county jails. Should be worked out but we will see how it goes. Been a few dark nights because of County staffing. Seems to be inconsistent on their end. Have set up more trainings for volunteers to do it online on the phone. Will call at 6pm on meeting nights to see how their staffing is for the night.
